Although the infamous number of 77 has entered the history books, the number of 'official' executions exceeds this and the NGA acknowledges that 81 republicans were executed in captivity, none having been afforded the basic human rights of a trial but whose lives were ended on the decision of their enemies, soldiers guided by political convenience, ignorant of basic legal principles and oblivious of the rights afforded to combatants by the Geneva Convention. The number of Republican prisoners shot by firing squad forms only a fraction of the total number of prisoners who were killed while in captivity in the years 1922-23. All are remembered with pride.
